Averages one bushel/ 8-10 varieties per week, with quantity and variety increasing as the season progresses. Approximately 22 weeks (June through October).	\$540.00	
<input type="checkbox"/> Taste of the Season - Features vegetables and herbs at the peak of their seasons. Smaller quantities than Harvest Basket, average 5-7 varieties/week. Approximately 22 weeks (June through October).	\$420.00	
<input type="checkbox"/> Fruit Share – Fresh berries, tree fruit, and melons from our own and other local farms. We choose fruit raised using organic or other sustainable methods when available, conventionally-grown when not. Approximately 16 deliveries (mid June through September).	\$150.00

Share Reservations and Payments

- * Shares will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis, with consideration for delivery logistics. A minimum non-refundable deposit of \$100 is required to reserve your share. A confirmation email will be sent to you when your membership is received and processed.
- * Your membership is a commitment for the full season. If you decide not to participate in the CSA prior to the start of deliveries, any payments made will be refunded minus the non-refundable \$100 deposit. There are no refunds once the delivery season has started.
- * There will be administrative charges of \$25 for any returned checks and \$5 per month for any late payments. Deliveries may be withheld at our discretion if payment is outstanding.
- * Members who choose to split a share with another household are responsible for dividing payments and produce themselves. The primary share member listed is responsible for submitting payments to us for any joint items.

CSA Share Deliveries

- * Shares are pre-packed at the farm in reusable boxes and fruit bags and delivered to the established delivery sites. Members should pick up their shares from their designated sites between 4:00-8:00 pm on delivery day (by 6:00 pm for OCFS Rensselaer site). Empty boxes from the previous week should be returned at the same time.
- * You may cancel a delivery with at least 24 hours advance notice. If some else is picking up your share, please fully explain the delivery system to them so they do not inadvertently take other members' items. Due to harvest and delivery logistics, we cannot accommodate changes in delivery sites or dates. There are no credits/refunds for missed deliveries.
- * As a courtesy to your site host, if you are late picking up a share please contact them. Any shares not picked up within 24 hours of delivery will be donated or discarded at your site host's discretion unless other arrangements are made.
- * Farming contains risks beyond our control. Sharing the risks of farming along with the benefits is a fundamental aspect of joining a CSA. We plan each season carefully and will work in good faith to fulfill our commitment. Like all small farms, we have years that are better or worse than others due to weather, insect pressure, seed quality and many other variables. We cannot guarantee the quantity or availability of any specific item and delivery schedules are subject to change.

Other CSA Membership Information

- * Member work is an important aspect of our CSA. Each member household is expected to contribute at least one working visit (about 2 ½ hours) or approved non-field work equivalent over the course of the season. This work commitment currently is optional but strongly encouraged. Members will receive in-kind financial credit for their work. For details on work opportunities and credits please refer to our Web site Member Pages.
- * CSA members are invited to visit the farm for scheduled work days, special farm events, or their own recreational use (hiking, picnicking, camping, etc.). Please contact us before visiting to make sure we are available.
- * Foxtail Farm uses email as the primary method of communication with members. Please provide one or more email addresses that you check regularly with your agreement and be sure to update us if your accounts change.
- * We frequently take photographs of members at work days and other farm events. By signing this form, members agree that we may use photos of them and their family on our Website, Facebook page or other materials. If you do not agree to this use, please make a note on your membership form or send us an email communication.

Acknowledgment of Risks and Hazards: Liability Release

- * By signing this agreement, members acknowledge that there are numerous hazards and risks inherent in being present on the farm and participating in farm activities, whether work or recreational in nature. While present on the farm, members are responsible for their own safety and that of their children or guests. Members freely accept responsibility for any and all risks of injury or death while participating in farm activities or while present on Foxtail Community Farm premises.
- * By signing this agreement, members agree to release, forever discharge, indemnify, defend and hold harmless Foxtail Community Farm, its owners, agents and employees from all liability for negligence and any and all losses, damages, costs and attorneys' fees resulting from any and all claims or suits for personal injuries, death and/or property damage of any kind while on the farm or after leaving the premises.
